Updates on Covid-19 Restrictions We received guidelines from the Archdiocese of Baltimore as we move forward

1. Receiving Communion– Guidelines remain the same: although receiving Holy Communion on the tongue is permitted, it is strongly recommended to receive Holy Communion in your hand. We will not distribute from the Blood of Christ from the chalice at this time.
2. Missalettes – Have been returned to the pews
3. Social Distancing -Will end on Fathers Day weekend June 19-20 (the Tape will come down)
4. Dispensation for Mass Obligation on Sundays - The Archbishop announced disposition will end the weekend of June 26 and 27
5. Confessions – We will continue with confessions in the Parish Hall on Saturdays from 3:15-4:15 pm until further notice.
6. Masks – You may remove your mask. It is strongly suggested that those of you who are not vaccinated keep your mask on. Please continue to sanitize your hands as you enter church.
